



JLA Intensive Summer Social Skills Program (ISSSP)

This program is based on school districts providing the staffing for program.

The Intensive Summer Social Skills Program (ISSSP) is a research-based and developed summer social skills program for children on the Autism Spectrum.

The program is designed specifically for students who meet the standard for Extended School Year services (ESY) due to their social skills regressing substantially without some type of services over the summer months. JLA will train the staff around Autism Spectrum Disorders; complete a pre-session consultation in order to preview baseline assessments and needs, and develop a schedule and lessons; and provide on-going consult throughout the program. In addition, another benefit to the school system is the building of capacity to run this program in subsequent years. Once we have trained staff and implemented the curriculum there will only be need for program consultation in future years.

JLA will:

- Provide a pre-session training to staff on ASD and how to teach the program (5 hours)
- Provide Pre-session(s) staff and consultant meeting to preview baseline assessments and needs, and to develop daily schedule and lessons (4-6 hours)
- Provide 3 hours per week of consult per group.
- Provide a researched and developed social skill program for children with ASD
