Managing Behavior: The Individual; The Classroom; and The School -- Level I

Training Level: Level 1
Times: 2-Day Intensive
Suggested Audience: Core Staff

This two-day Skills intensive workshop is designed to assist participants in the development of strengthening their skills “approach” for the individual, the classroom and the overall school. Training includes the development of an action plan for managing behavior and utilizing tools and techniques that will assist in identifying goals for which behaviors to increase and which to decrease. Skills building will include:

- Individual, Case Studies, or Formal Teaching/Coaching of Skills
- “Incentivizing” Skills

Training provides monitoring and tracking systems that will enable both the classroom and the school the ability to collect data for evidence-based success.

Training Level: Level 2
Times: 3-Days (2-Day Intensive and 1 Day Training for Building Staff)
Suggested Audience: All Levels

Participants in this three day training workshop will learn how to develop an action plan for managing behavior across three separate levels – the individual, the classroom, and the overall school; goal setting: identifying goals for which behaviors to increase and which to decrease; behavioral and academic goals; how to monitor progress, group skills lessons, and the creation of a basic token



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economy system. Additionally, participants will focus on increasing skills through formal & informal generalized interventions through the use of individual and school-wide coaching. Training provides monitoring and tracking systems that will enable both the classroom and the school the ability to collect data for evidence-based success.

Training Level: Level 3
Times: 3-Days (2-Day Intensive and 1 Day Overview, Ongoing Consultation)
Suggested Audience: Core Staff

Instructor/Trainer: Johanna Hammer, LICSW

The Level 3 training program incorporates both Level 1 & Level 2 programs, including clinical consultation for the program. The ongoing clinical consultation supports the integrity of the program through continued skills development including: relationship skills, responsive discipline, and individual and school-wide coaching. Consultation will/can include on-site visits or visits via video-conferencing depending on location. Training provides monitoring and tracking systems that will enable both the classroom and the school the ability to collect data for evidence-based success.
